



TAB YOUNG PROFESSIONAL AWARD OF EXCELLENCE

Purpose

To honour, recognize and celebrate the accomplishments of a young professional in the Records and Information Management Profession of the ARMA Canada Region of ARMA International.

The Young Professional Award of Excellence will be presented to a young Records and Information Management professional who has pursued excellence in their career, the RIM Profession and/or their workplace. The recipient will also exemplify preeminent service to a Canadian ARMA chapter or the ARMA Canada Region.

Recognition

The Successful Recipient(s) will:

- Receive funding up to \$3,000 to attend the annual ARMA Canada Conference and Leadership Sessions. (Sponsored by TAB).
- Be presented with the award at the Awards Banquet during the ARMA Canada Conference.

Eligibility & Selection

1. Nominee must be:

- A Canadian ARMA member in good standing;
- A young professional. ARMA Canada has defined a Young Professional being 35 years of age or younger or new to the profession (within 5 years).

2. The nominee's contribution(s) and/or achievements must be documented to include:

- What their participation is at the Chapter or Canadian Region level;
- How they have and/or are pursuing excellence in their career, RIM profession or workplace.

Evidence may be provided in the form of references containing personal testimonies or corroboration of a committee, chapter, Region Coordinator.
